Colossians 2:13-15

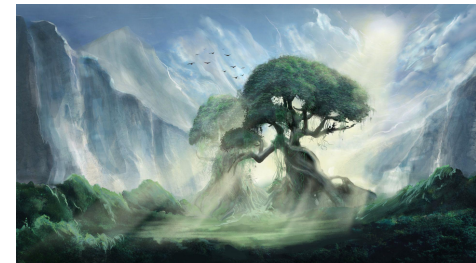
